## About this document

This document describes the changes that have been implemented in ABBYY FlexiCapture 12 Release 4 Update 2 Patch 1.

## About the product

ABBYY FlexiCapture 12 is the latest version of ABBYY FlexiCapture, a highly scalable and flexible data capture platform for creating region-specific and vertical data capture solutions.

## About the patch

This patch includes a feature that implements OAuth authorization for IMAP for Microsoft Exchange, as well as critical bug fixes. This release is incremental for ABBYY FlexiCapture 12 Release 4 Update 2 and includes all features and fixes from that release.

## NEW FEATURES

### 1.1. OAuth authorization for IMAP for Microsoft Exchange

Starting from October 1, 2022, Microsoft disabled Basic authentication for Outlook, EWS, RPS, POP, IMAP, and EAS protocols in Exchange Online. If you are using Basic authentication in your FlexiCapture 12 "Image Import Profiles" setup with the mentioned protocols, it may fail with errors on or after October 1, 2022. To avoid this, support for OAuth2 for IMAP import has been added in ABBYY FlexiCapture 12 Release 4 Update 2 Patch 1.

To set up the import profile for IMAP import with OAuth2 authentication:

1. In the Import Profile Wizard, select **Hot Folder** as the import source.
2. Select **IMAP server** as the type of your Hot Folder.
3. Specify the address of the IMAP server (e.g. imap.server.com).
4. Click **Settings...** and in the dialog box that opens, select the **Use OAuth 2.0 authentication** option.
5. Click **Sign in....**The OAuth 2.0 Authorization Wizard will be launched.
6. Click the link in the OAuth 2.0 Authorization Wizard to sign in to your Microsoft account.
7. Grant the required permissions to the application.
8. Return to the OAuth 2.0 Authorization Wizard and click **Finish**.

You can also modify your existing Image Import Profiles with IMAP import.
