ABBYY Vantage connector for Microsoft Power Automate

Introduction

The ABBYY Vantage connector for Microsoft Power Automate is a connector for Microsoft Power Automate platform. Developers can use this connector to add data extraction and document classification functionality to automation flows. This is a redistributable package for manual installation.

ABBYY Vantage is a cloud-based document processing solution that provides optical recognition, document classification, and data extraction functionality.

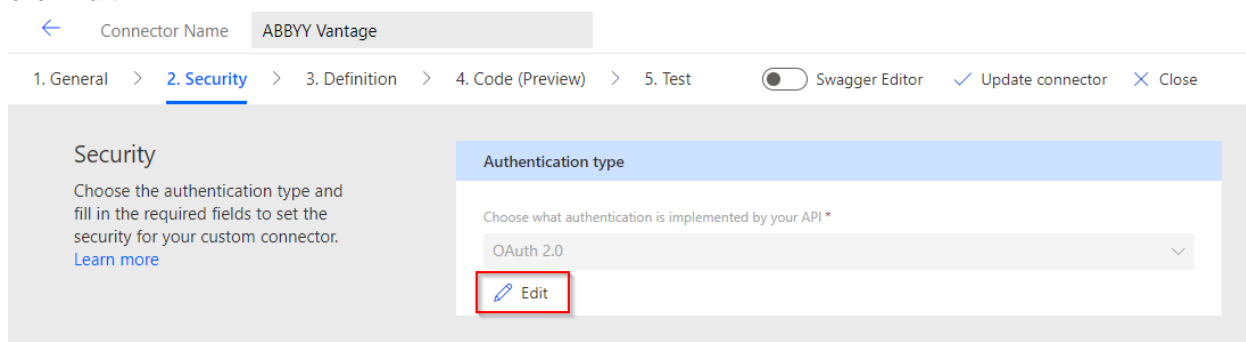
Release Goal

The goal of this release is to provide support for the Vantage Public API refresh token, allowing the connection to stay alive for up to 30 days.

After 30 days the client will have to reauthenticate for the next 30 days, this is a known issue.

Upgrade procedure

1. In Power Automate go to **Data > Custom connectors**. Edit your ABBYY Vantage custom connector.
2. In the connector editor go to the **Security** tab and click **Edit** :



3. Fill in again the fields that became empty in edit mode:
 - a. **Client id**: ABBYY.PowerAutomate
 - b. **Client secret**: Vezu_jgEw8kFi1ugXb66s2buh6ZC1M-Uf9
 - c. **Refresh URL**: the same endpoint as Token URL:
https://<vantage_server_address>/auth2/connect/token

4. Add **offline_access** scope in the **Scope** field:
